Fourteen men, including Nick and event organiser **Andrew Poole**, right, took part in the 1050km journey.

“It's just been amazing, the experience along the way has been incredible,” Nick says.

The foundation was established in honour of Nick's wife, **Jodi**, who lost her two-year battle with bowel cancer last year. The little black dress (LBD) was Jodi's favourite outfit and each member of the peloton wore one.

INXS in town to kick off tour

INXS is headed for Adelaide. To kick off the band's first Australian tour in four years, INXS will play exclusively for A Day on the Green's 10th season.

SA will rock out at Annie's Lane in the Clare Valley, where INXS will play with special guest **JD Fortune**, pictured here with guitarist **Tim Farriss**.

The A Day on the Green tour reaches Annie's Lane on February 5.

US Grammy Award-winners **Train**, the reformed **Baby Animals** and ARIA Hall of Fame inductee **Sean Kelly**, of **Models** fame, are also part of the line-up.

Train lead singer **Pat Monahan** is expected to take the stage with the band to recreate his stunning version of *Beautiful Girl* from the *Original Sin* album.

Train is also working on some surprise new arrangements of favourite INXS tracks.

Canadian JD Fortune left the band in 2009 amid controversy but is rejoining it for the Australian leg of the tour. It would appear past grudges are behind them, with the focus on the future.

Most recently **Kirk Pengilly**, of INXS, married champion surfer **Layne Beachley**.
