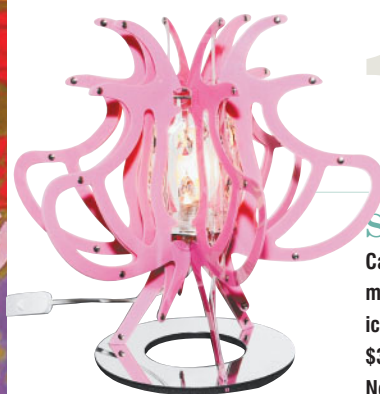


BIG WRAP ON SALE

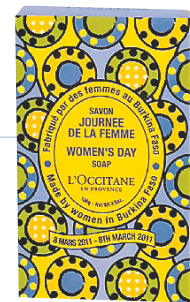
